

<u>CPAD BOARD REGULAR MEETING</u> <u>MINUTES</u>

- 5) PUBLIC FORUM/PUBLIC COMMENT: Only items that are within the jurisdiction of CPAD will be considered. Statements from the floor will be heard during public forum/public comment; public comments are limited to one 5-minute comment per person per topic. Requests requiring board action will be referred to staff and brought on the next appropriate agenda.

6) OLD BUSINESS:

- a) OBSTRUCTION MITIGATION EFFORTS:
 - i. CalFire visits: South field clean-up, brush burning
 - ii. Continued trimming of in-CPAD trees
- b) <u>CRACK SEALING AT NORTH TAXIWAY</u>: Thank you to David Becker for brining his personal equipment out to repair the significant lateral cracking on the north taxiway. Nice job!
- c) <u>LIGHT SHED FLOODING</u>: Successful installation of underslab and conduit drain systems now stops water intrusion along the conduits. This was a significant problem creating water flowing through the wiring conduits into the shed and around the base of the high voltage power supply.

d) ADA COMPLIANT WEBSITE

The new ADA compliant website is ready. Content will improve in due course, but the communications shortcomings identified in the 2016 Grand Jury report and additional requirements active as of January 1, 2020, are now addressed. - e) <u>FISCAL AUDITS FY17-18 & FY 18-19</u>: Underway. Great prep assistance rendered by CPAD bookkeeper Anna Bartosh
- f) AIR PARK SELF STORAGE: Development project is alive with Design Review application submitted to El Dorado County and Cameron Park CSD. CPAD has sent a written response and has representatives attending the planning meeting tonight to inform them of issues not addressed in building next to an airport.

7) NEW BUSINESS:

- a) OBSTRUCTION LIGHT 3 CONSULTING: Convergence of high trees, proposed residential construction and the existing obstruction light #3 may benefit form professional analysis and guidance to define approaches to mitigation and expedite resolution. Proposal to Board of Directors is to open a Request for Proposals to undertake this limited work. Intend to obtain cost estimates for such statement of work.
 - 1. MOTION to approve Request for Qulaifications/Proposal form consulting engineering firms for purposes of assessing best solutions to tree obstruction on south runway 31 approach.

- <u>b) CPAD MID- AND LONG RANGE FINANCIAL PLANNING:</u> Introduction of Airport Financial Needs and Income Committee with leadership by Director Knud Kirkegaard (CFI)AIRPORT ACCESS POLICY: Introduction of proposed airport access policy.
- c) AIRPORT ACCESS POLICY: Introduction of proposed airport access policy. **Intend to propose adoption at the next meeting.**
- <u>d) WEBSITE ADMINISTRATION & POLICY</u>: Introduce web site management policy. **Intend to propose adoption at the next meeting.**
- <u>e) OFFICE RENOVATION</u>: Updated proposal for office renovation. Revised plan for replacing fixtures, carpet, lights and paint. **Final scope and funding will be requested at the next meeting. Note \$1500 budgeted and not spent to date.**

<u>f) SURPLUS CERTAIN OBSOLETE CPAD ASSETS</u>: Surplus material located at lighting shed, light fixture parts, old traffic cones, tractor air filter, tractor mount spray rig, misc stuff outside.

g) ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY ACCESS GATE: Proposal for new (incremental) gate through the chain link fence at south end of field (near corner of Cameron Park Drive and Oxford). A small grass fire demonstrated we have poor access for CalFire/EMS to that area. There is a gate at Dave's Rental Car which may be blocked due to parked vehicles. There is a gate near Mr. Byrne's residence, but terrain is not favorable to fire trucks. An additional gate is suggested after coordination with Cameron Park Fire.
