**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CAMERON PARK AIRPORT DISTRICT
AUTHORIZING THE ANNUAL LEVY OF SPECIAL TAXES**

WHEREAS, the Cameron Park Airport District ("District") is a special district organized and existing under the California Public Utilities Code Sections 22001, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2022, the Board of Directors of the District ("the Board") adopted Resolution 22-01, which placed a ballot measure before the voters to increase the annual special tax from \$300 to \$900 per parcel; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2022, the voters of the District approved said measure, authorizing the District to levy a special tax for an unlimited duration to fund airport operations, airport maintenance, and residential street maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the voter-approved ballot measure specified that the \$900 annual special tax be apportioned as follows: \$600 for airport operations and maintenance, and \$300 for maintenance of the residential streets within the District; and

WHEREAS, the District now desires to authorize the levy of these special taxes commenced Fiscal Year 2023/24 and confirm the ongoing authority for subsequent fiscal years in accordance with the unlimited duration authorized by the electorate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Cameron Park Airport District as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Authorization of Levy. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the levy of the special tax for Fiscal Year 2026/27 and subsequent fiscal years at the rate of \$900 per parcel. The special tax shall be collected in the same manner as ordinary ad valorem property taxes are collected and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedure provided for ad valorem taxes. The District Manager or their designee are authorized to provide the necessary parcel tax roll to the El Dorado County Auditor-Controller/Tax Collector for placement on the secured property tax roll of the County of El Dorado.

Section 3. Apportionment of Funds. In accordance with Resolution 22-01 and the approved ballot measure, the proceeds of the special tax shall be apportioned and restricted as follows:

- \$600 per parcel for Airport Operations and Maintenance.
- \$300 per parcel for Residential Street Maintenance.

Section 4. Duration. The Board hereby acknowledges and confirms that the authority to levy this special tax was granted by the voters for an unlimited duration. This resolution shall serve as the basis for the annual levy commencing Fiscal Year 2026/27 and all subsequent fiscal years unless otherwise amended or rescinded by the Board of Directors.
