## **Airport Access Requirements**

February 17, 2020

This Resolution will replace all previous resolutions on this topic

All non-aircraft access to the airport shall follow the following rules.

Gate codes, residential gate clickers and RF cards for the gate near the office shall be issued according to the rules in those specific policy statements.

Vehicles and pedestrians without specific authorization shall remain on the paved office area, paved taxiway (do not cross hold short lines), tie-down and hangar areas that have been designated as mixed use areas. Aircraft have the right of way and speed is 15mph or less.

All pets shall be on a leash and in control at all times. All pet waste shall be immediately picked up and properly disposed of.

Vehicles within the airport boundary shall only be parked within the specific aircraft hangar or tie down space and shall not block access to any taxiway, hanger etc.

No person shall operate a vehicle in a reckless or negligent manner

No person may operate a vehicle under the influence of any intoxicating liquor or drug

Every accident involving bodily injury or property damage in excess of \$200 shall be reported to the airport manager

Anyone not in an aircraft (walking, any form of vehicle) that are crossing the hold short lines, traveling on the runway, or traversing any other airport area except that defined above shall observe the following.

- 1. Carry a working two way radio tuned to 123.05 and announce when they cross the hold short line each direction
  - 2. Pedestrians or anyone outside a vehicle shall wear a reflective vest or clothing
  - 3. Notify the airport manager prior to the access
  - 4. People unfamiliar with the operation of this airport shall be escorted at the discretion of the manager.

Unauthorized airport access shall be considered trespassing

Violation of these rules will result in forfeiture of any gate access cards or clickers.

Access for visiting/transient aircraft:

Transient aircraft may enter the residential area for short term stays (36 hours?). They must be in contact with a resident and comply with all airport and resident rules. Transient aircraft will not be issued or loaned gate access clickers or cards. They must contact the airport manager for gate operation or the resident can use their issued card or clicker to allow airport access.
